Students are invited to incorporate this theme in their wheels decorations. **Motorized vehicles are not permitted.** School will start at the regular time on Friday, June 16th and Sports Day should be completed at approximately 1:45 p.m. Please pre-order your food as a limited supply of extra food items will be available at concession on Sports Day. If your child's classroom does not have an outside door, please arrange to meet your child near his/hers usual exit door or a meeting place on the playground to enjoy a family or friend picnic together. Delta Police Department is pleased to offer a week camp from **August 28th to September 1st**. Players will be placed into groups based on age and ability to ensure they are challenged appropriately, maximizing their development and most importantly, having fun! We will cover the following topics during the week:

- shooting and finishing
- passing
- dribbling and turning
- ball control and trapping
- game situations, small-sided games
- positional play, attacking and defending
- mini World Cup

Proper technique of all skills will be demonstrated and encouraged, as well as the use of both feet. Camp players will participate in an environment where they will be coached by and be playing with experienced, quality soccer players and coaches. Coaches will be members from the Delta Police Department with a soccer background and high level senior players from the community.


